Summer Arts Scholarship Program

- Inaugurated summer 2022
- Opportunities ranged from introductory programs to intensive programs
- Over 700 students submitted applications of interest
- Over 200 students submitted full applications
- 124 recipients in grades 6-12 received \$166,420 in scholarships to attend summer art programs in New York State
- 48% of the recipients received scholarships totaling 90% of their chosen program's cost





Representation and **Programs**
