

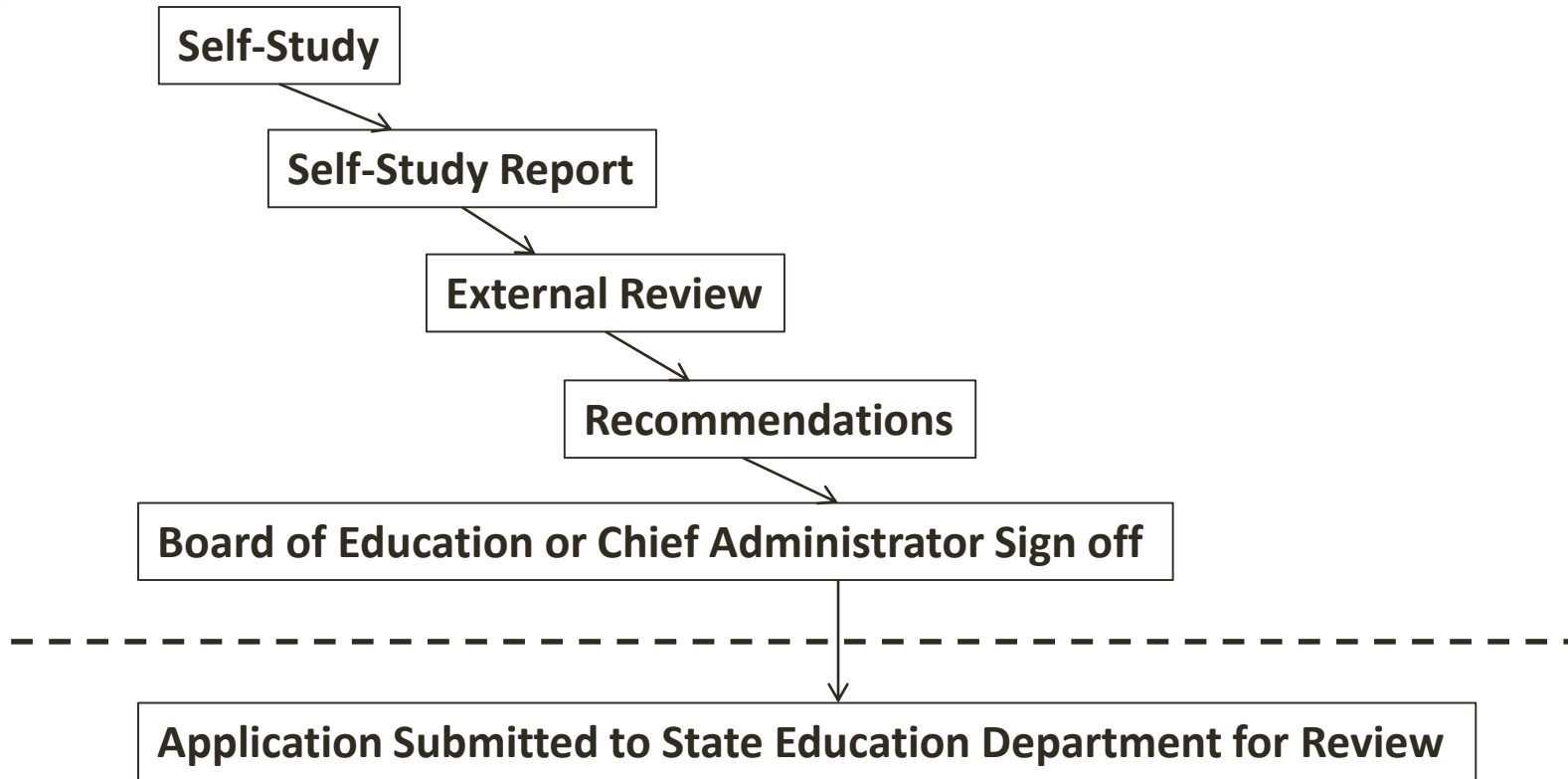
Career and Technical Education Update

Current Data

- 1,068 Approved Programs
 - 680 BOCES
 - 388 School Districts
- Programs may reapply at the end of a 5-year period
- Career and Technical Education (CTE) Office reviews 100-300 new and re-approval applications annually
- Programs consist of 3-8 credits including Career and Financial Management (CFM) content
- 282 Unique Technical Assessments being used
