

SUMMARY

Issue for (Consent Agenda)

Should the Board of Regents approve the registration of a nonpublic high school in pending status?

Reason(s) for Consideration

Required by State statute.

Proposed Handling

This question will come before the Regents for approval at its October 2016 meeting.

Procedural History

The Board of Regents has taken action on the registration of nonpublic high schools each year.

Background Information

This nonpublic high school had a senior class for the first time in 2008. In 2008, the school submitted an application for Nonpublic Secondary Registration and was visited by a staff member from the Office for Nonpublic Schools. At that time, the school was placed in pending registration status, pending investments in improved facilities. In 2016, staff from the Office for Nonpublic Schools re-visited the school and found that it has met the requirements for a registered school.

Approved registration will allow the school to issue valid diplomas and administer State examinations on-site, and the school will become a member of the University of the State of New York.
