

**SUBJECT:** Petition of the City School District of the City of Olean for Consent to Exceed the Constitutional Debt Limit

**SUMMARY**

**Issue for Decision (Consent Agenda)**

Should the Regents consent to allow the City School District of the City of Olean to increase the indebtedness of the school district under the provisions of the State Constitution and the Local Finance Law?

**Reason(s) for Consideration**

Required by Article 8, Section 4, Paragraph (h) of the State Constitution and by Local Finance Law section 104.00(c).

**Proposed Handling**

This petition for consent will come before the Board of Regents at the November 2016 meeting for action.

**Procedural History**

The Board of Regents is required to give consent for such petitions prior to the petition being forwarded to the State Comptroller for final consideration. The Board of Regents has discussed in the past similar requests from school districts to exceed their debt limit and is familiar with the guidelines and procedures for granting consent.

## **Background Information**

The Department received a petition from the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Olean seeking consent of the Board of Regents to an increase in the indebtedness of the Olean City School District.

The State Constitution requires that any increase in the constitutional limit on local indebtedness for a school district wholly or partly within a city of less than 125,000 inhabitants receive: (1) the approving vote of 60 percent or more of the duly qualified voters; (2) the consent of the Regents; and (3) the consent of the State Comptroller.

According to the submitted petition, the Olean City School District is located in the southeastern portion of Cattaraugus County. The documentation supporting the petition verifies that more than 60 percent of duly qualified voters approved the increase at a special meeting held on March 15, 2016. The increase in indebtedness will be used for renovations and upgrades in the Olean Senior High/Middle School, Washington West Elementary and East View Elementary. Staff has reviewed the petition and supporting documentation and recommends that the requested consent be granted.

## **Recommendation**

VOTED: That the Board of Regents hereby gives consent to the issuance of bonds and/or bond anticipation notes by the Board of Education of the City School District of the City of Olean for a total in an amount not to exceed \$12,150,000, with \$900,000 to be expended from the existing building capital reserve fund and \$4,000,000, for a total request of \$15,250,000 to be used for certain capital improvements consisting of addition to and reconstruction of school buildings and facilities for and the issuance of such bonds and/or bond anticipation notes in excess of the constitutional debt limit of said school district.

## **Timetable for Implementation**

Upon approval by the Board of Regents, the petition will be forwarded to the State Comptroller for final consideration.
