

SUMMARY

Issue for Decision

Will the Board of Regents approve my appointment of Angelique Johnson-Dingle to Deputy Commissioner, P-12 Instructional Support?

Reason for Consideration

Angelique Johnson-Dingle will bring to the Deputy Commissioner, P-12 Instructional Support position extensive pedagogical and leadership experience working with schools, districts, and BOCES across New York State. Ms. Johnson-Dingle is currently serving as the District Superintendent of the Western Suffolk BOCES. She began her career as an elementary school teacher in the East Ramapo Central School District before transitioning to the high school level to progressively serve as a Reading and Language Arts Teacher, Literacy Coach, Facilitator for Small Learning Communities, and Summer School Assistant Principal at the Uniondale High School. Ms. Johnson-Dingle then served as a Teacher Center Director and Divisional Director for Instructional Support Services at the Western Suffolk BOCES before assuming her current role. Ms. Johnson-Dingle holds two Master of Science degrees, one in Educational Administration and the other in Education from Long Island University, and a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Lincoln University. Ms. Johnson-Dingle also holds New York State Permanent Certifications in Elementary Education, Reading, and as a School District Administrator.

Proposed Handling

This appointment will come before the Full Board of Regents for final action at its February 2022 meeting.

Recommendation
