


SUMMARY

Issue for Decision (Consent Agenda)

Should the Regents approve the appointments of Melvin Taylor and Maria Mingoelli to the Board of Visitors at the New York State School for the Deaf?

Proposed Handling

This item will come before the Board of Regents for action at the September 2012 meeting.

Procedural History

Each year, as vacancies occur, the Board of Regents approves recommendations to fill such vacancies.

Background Information

Section 4353 of Education Law requires the Board of Regents to appoint an Advisory Board of Visitors of the New York State School for the Deaf in Rome, New York.

Recommendation

The following individuals will be appointed to fill two vacancies on the New York State School for the Deaf Board of Visitors: Melvin Taylor will be appointed to serve a five-year term ending June 30, 2017; and Maria Mingoelli will be appointed to serve a five-year term ending June 30, 2017. Information on the proposed appointees is noted on Attachment 1.

Timetable for Implementation

If approved, Mr. Taylor and Ms. Mingoelli will begin serving at the September 2012 Board of Visitors meeting.
