SUMMARY

Reason(s) for Discussion

Two students and the Director from the Amsterdam Smart Scholars Early College High School (SS-ECHS) project along with two students from the Hamilton-Fulton-Montgomery NYS Pathways in Technology (NYS P-TECH) project and their Principal will discuss the successes and challenges experienced in their respective programs.

Proposed Handling

This item will come before the Higher Education Committee for discussion at its October 2017 meeting.

Background Information

Smart Scholars Early College High School

The Smart Scholars Early College High School (SS-ECHS) program, specifically though not exclusively, recruits students on free and reduced lunch and helps students who have traditionally had low rates of college enrollment and completion. The program gives students the opportunity to accelerate the completion of their high school studies while earning college credits at the same time. Students receive additional academic support from school/college partnerships to ensure they are at grade level and ready to participate in rigorous collegiate courses. The program increases high school graduation and college completion rates among those who historically have not had similar

opportunities to succeed, while reducing student tuition costs to complete a college degree.

The first cohort of SS-ECHS partnerships began in January 2010 with funding from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. The second SS-ECHS partnerships cohort was funded by the State and initiated in April 2011. In 2015-2016, there were 24 SS-ECHS projects across the State with a total of 6,056 students from the 9th through the 12th grades.

NYS Pathways in Technology

The NYS Pathways in Technology (NYS P-TECH) program is a public-private partnership preparing academically and/or economically at-risk New York students for high-skills jobs of the future in technology, manufacturing, healthcare, and finance. The model incorporates a six-year integrated program that combines high school, college, and career training. Students will earn their NYS Regents diploma, a cost-free Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree, or other two-year degrees (A.S., A.O.S.) that are the industry standard for targeted jobs, and be first in line for job opportunities with business/employer partners. Through this program, students have access to additional academic support from both the high school and college partners, preparation that promotes informed and appropriate career choices, and the opportunity to complete their high school and college requirements in six years or less at no cost to them or their families.

By combining State appropriated funds and federal Perkins funds from the Department, the 2013-2014 statewide initiative awarded \$4.4 million through a competitive Request for Proposals to 16 NYS P-TECH projects representing the 10 economic regions of New York. Additionally, Governor Cuomo announced \$5 million in the 2014-15 State Budget to award a second cohort of 10 projects and \$3 million in the 2015-16 State Budget to award a third cohort of 6 projects. In 2016-17, there were 32 NYS P-TECH projects, representing all 10 NYS economic regions, with approximately 3,357 freshmen, sophomore, and senior students representing 163 school districts (44 of which are in Priority Status), and partnered with 26 colleges and 431 business/employer partners.
