## **Issue for Decision**

## **Reason for Consideration**

Alison Bianchi will bring to the Counsel position more than 14 years of experience in education policy and law through positions at the State Education Department and the New York State School Boards Association. For the past six years, Ms. Bianchi served as Deputy Counsel at the Department, providing legal advice and counsel to the Board of Regents, Commissioner and Department staff on critical policy matters and key initiatives and managing the day-to-day operations of the office. Prior to that, she served in NYSED's Office of State Assessment and as project manager for various Department initiatives. Previously, Ms. Bianchi also was associate editor at Lawyers Weekly USA where she researched and produced stories on state and federal case law and legislation. Ms. Bianchi holds a bachelor's degree from Colgate University and earned her juris doctorate at Boston University School of Law.
