SUMMARY

Issue for Decision

Should the Board of Regents approve the proposed revision to the charter of the following charter school authorized by the New York City Department of Education Chancellor pursuant to Article 56 of the Education Law (the New York Charter Schools Act)?

Imagine Me Leadership Charter School (Revision to change from an all-boys model in K through Grade 8 to an all-boys model in K through Grade 5 and a coeducational model in Grades 6-8).

Reason(s) for Consideration

Required by State statute.

Proposed Handling

This issue will come before the P-12 Education Committee and the Full Board for action at its April 2022 meeting.

Procedural History

The New York State Education Department (the Department) made the revision recommendations being presented to the Board of Regents for approval and issuance as required by Article 56 of the Education Law.

Background Information

The New York City Department of Education Chancellor, Board of Regents, and the Department are bound by Article 56 of the Education Law regarding the criteria that can be considered in decision making pertaining to charter school renewals and revisions.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Regents take the following action(s):

VOTED: That the Board of Regents finds that **Imagine Me Leadership Charter School**: (1) meets the requirements set out in Article 56 of the Education Law, and all other applicable laws, rules and regulations; (2) the applicant can demonstrate the ability to operate the school in an educationally and fiscally sound manner; (3) granting the application is likely to improve student learning and achievement and materially further the purposes set out in subdivision two of Section twenty-eight hundred fifty of this article; and (4) granting the application would have a significant educational benefit to the students expected to attend the charter school, and the Board of Regents therefore approves the charter revision of **Imagine Me Leadership Charter School** and amends the provisional charter accordingly.

Timetable for Implementation

The Regents action for the above-named charter school will become effective immediately.

The requested revisions will have no bearing on the number of students being served by this charter school, which will not change, nor will the revision impact the number of charters available for issuance in New York City or the State.

Approving this revision request will result in a significant educational benefit to the students expected to attend the charter school because the school has a strong record of outperforming schools in the CSD; this proposed revision will provide significant educational benefit to the girls who attend.

The Board of Regents granted an initial charter to Imagine Me Leadership Charter School (IMLCS) in January 2010. IMLCS commenced instruction in September 2010, initially serving 108 students in K through Grade 1. Imagine Me Leadership Charter School's charter was subsequently renewed by the Board of Regents in 2015, 2016 and 2019 (with a revision to expand from K- Grade 5 to K-Grade 8).

The charter school's Board of Trustees requests that the Board of Regents approve a material revision to the school's charter to move from an all-boys model from K to Grade 8 to a model that also serves girls in Grade 6 through 8. There is demonstrated demand from families with middle school girls in the Community School District; current parents have been thoughtfully engaged around this and IMLCS reports that they are in favor of this change. The school has carefully started the process of adjusting the character and leadership strands of the model to be responsive to girls' needs, as they have done for the needs of boys. This proposed change will not displace any boys currently enrolled in the school; rather, all open seats in the middle school will be available to applicants from both genders. The NYC DOE will work closely with Imagine Me to implement strategies towards a 50/50 percent enrollment of males and females in the middle school grades including, but not limited to, enrollment preferences.
