


**SUMMARY**

Issue for Decision (Consent Agenda)

Should the Board of Regents approve the registration of five nonpublic high schools?

Reason(s) for Consideration

Required by State statute.

Proposed Handling

This question will come before the Regents at its May 2013 meeting for action.

Procedural History

The Board of Regents takes action on the registration of nonpublic high schools.

Background Information

Nonpublic schools that have a senior class for the first time submit an Application for Nonpublic Secondary School Registration and are visited by a staff member from the Office for Nonpublic Schools. Approved registration of a nonpublic high school allows the school to issue valid Regents diplomas and administer State examinations on-site, and the school becomes a member of the University of the State of New York.

## Recommendation

VOTED: That the following schools, which participated in the 2012-13 nonpublic high school registration program, be registered:
