# Issue for Decision (Consent)

Should the Board of Regents approve the reappointment of a member to the New York State Teachers' Retirement System Board?

# Reason(s) for Consideration

Required by State statute.

# **Proposed Handling**

This issue will come before the Full Board for action at its May 2024 meeting.

# **Procedural History**

Appointment of certain members to the 10-member board of the New York State Teachers' Retirement System (NYSTRS) Board requires approval by the Board of Regents.

Education Law §504(2)(c) provides that:

Two administrative officers of the New York State school system, appointed by the commissioner of education, each to serve for a term of three years.

## **Background Information**

Reappointment under Section 504(2)c of the Education Law:

In accordance with this provision, the New York State Teacher's Retirement System (NYSTRS) recommended the re-appointment of current member Dr. Phyllis Harrington, whose term expires June 30, 2024. The New York State Council of School Superintendents (NYSCOSS) joins in these recommendations.

Dr. Harrington was first appointed to the NYSTRS Board on October 14, 2010, to fill the unexpired term of the then-retiring Dr. Rosemary F. Jones. Dr. Harrington currently serves as the Superintendent for the Oceanside School District. She has had a distinguished career in education for over 25 years, together with an impressive record of community service. She currently chairs the NYSTRS Board's Compensation Committee and serves on the Board's Audit, Ethics, and Executive Committee. Copies of letters from the NYSCOSS and NYSTRS recommending Dr. Harrington are attached (Attachment A). Dr. Harrington's resume (Attachment B) is also attached.
