Master Plan Amendment Application

Issue for Decision (Consent)

Should the Board of Regents approve the proposed master plan amendment applications?

Reason for Consideration

Required by State Statute (Education Law section 237).

Proposed Handling

The issue will come before the Full Board for action at its May 2024 meeting.

Procedural History

Not applicable.

Background Information

When a college or university seeks to expand its academic mission (e.g., by offering a degree at a new level of study or in a new disciplinary area or establishing a new branch campus), it must submit a master plan amendment application for review and approval by the Board of Regents. Depending upon the nature of the proposed programs that require the master plan amendment, the application will be submitted to either the Department's Office of Higher Education or Office of the Professions. An amendment of an institution's master plan must be approved by the Board of Regents before the institution can undertake the proposed activities.

An academic review of the proposed master plan amendments have been completed by the Department. The Department determined that the proposed programs meet the standards for registration set forth in the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education. If charter amendments are also necessary (e.g., to establish a new branch campus), they are indicated on the summary table (see the attachment below) and the charter amendment is included in the Charter Applications item on the Full Board agenda.

Timetable for Implementation

A master plan amendment is required because the proposed programs will be the institution's first master's programs in the discipline area of Education. The programs were proposed by the College as a result of Clarkson University's discontinuance of its educator preparation programs.
