

### **SUMMARY**

#### **Issue for Decision (Consent Agenda)**

Should the Board of Regents approve the registration of eight nonpublic high schools?

#### **Reason(s) for Consideration**

Required by State statute.

#### **Proposed Handling**

This question will come before the Regents at its July 2016 meeting.

#### **Procedural History**

The Board of Regents has taken action on the registration of nonpublic high schools each year.

#### **Background Information**

Nonpublic high schools which had a senior class for the first time submitted Applications for Nonpublic Secondary School Registration and were visited by a staff member from the Office for Nonpublic Schools.

Approved registration of nonpublic high schools will allow them to issue valid diplomas and administer State examinations on-site, and the schools will become members of the University of the State of New York.
