SUMMARY

Issue for Decision (Consent)

Should the Regents approve the recommendations of the Committee on the Professions pertaining to licensing petitions and degree conferrals as listed on the attachment?

Section 6506(5) of the Education Law and Section 24.7 of the Rules of the Board of Regents authorize the Regents to waive education, experience and examination requirements for a professional license as well as to confer the degree Doctor of Medicine.

There are four licensing petitions and 51 requests for the conferral of the degree of Doctor of Medicine for review and determination.

(Federal University of Ceara, Fortaleza, Brazil, Titulo de Cirurgiao Dentista, December 1994)

Petition for: Acceptance of education.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Regulations of the Commissioner require an applicant for licensure in dentistry to complete an acceptable preprofessional education program of at least two years in length (including courses in general chemistry, organic chemistry, biology or zoology, and physics) and an acceptable professional dental education program of at least four years in length, for a total of six years of preprofessional and professional education.

Part 24.3(a)(1) of the Rules of the Board of Regents allows the Committee on the Professions the authority to waive up to six semester hours of preprofessional education, and §24.3(a)(2) of the Rules of the Board of Regents gives the Committee on the Professions the authority to accept postsecondary study after completion of professional study in lieu of up to 30 semester hours of preprofessional study.

Dr. De Araujo Lima completed a four-year professional dental education program at Federal University of Ceara in Fortaleza, Brazil. Therefore, he lacks two years of education which is in the preprofessional area.

However, Dr. De Araujo Lima also completed graduate coursework from March 2005 until August 2007, culminating in a Master of Dentistry and graduate coursework from April 2013 until February 2018, culminating in a Doctor of Dentistry at Federal University of Ceara in Fortaleza, Brazil. The Executive Secretary for the State Board for Dentistry recommends that these studies be considered to fulfill the two years of required preprofessional education.

(All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, Delhi, India, Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery, March 1991)

Petition for: Endorsement of applicant's medical license from India.

Statement of Problem: Commissioner's Regulations allow endorsement of an applicant's license from another jurisdiction if appropriate requirements are met, and the applicant has not failed any part of New York State's licensing examination. A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.

Dr. Ahluwalia lacks three years of accredited postgraduate training. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine has reviewed the documentation submitted in support of Dr. Ahluwalia's application. He recommends that Dr. Ahluwalia's training be accepted as the equivalent of the three years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training required for licensure.

Commissioner's Regulations allow the Board of Regents to accept appropriate foreign medical licenses and diplomate certificates to fulfill the license, proficiency, and clinical competency requirements for New York State licensure by endorsement. Dr. Ahluwalia obtained his medical license in India in 2006. His Indian license is active and in good standing. Additionally, Dr. Ahluwalia is ECFMG certified and passed examination of the Internal Medicine Specialty Certificate, Degree of Doctor of Medicine in April 1994.

The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine recommends that Dr. Ahluwalia's Indian license be endorsed, and his ECFMG certification and Internal Medicine Specialty Certificate, Degree of Doctor of Medicine be accepted to fulfill the proficiency and clinical competency requirements for endorsement.

<u>Petition for</u>: Endorsement of applicant's medical license from Turkey.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Commissioner's Regulations allow endorsement of an applicant's license from another jurisdiction if appropriate requirements are met, and the applicant has not failed any part of New York State's licensing examination. A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.

Dr. Belirgen lacks three years of accredited postgraduate training. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine has reviewed the documentation submitted in support of Dr. Belirgen's application. He recommends that Dr. Belirgen's training be accepted as the equivalent of the three years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training required for licensure.

Commissioner's Regulations allow the Board of Regents to accept appropriate foreign medical licenses and diplomate certificates to fulfill the license, proficiency, and clinical competency requirements for New York State licensure by endorsement. Dr. Belirgen obtained his medical license in Turkey in 2008. His Turkish license is active and in good standing. Additionally, Dr. Belirgen has ECFMG certification and holds a Turkish State Specialist Diploma in Neurosurgery issued in December 2007.

The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine recommends that Dr. Belirgen's Turkish license be endorsed, and his Specialist Diploma in Neurosurgery be accepted to fulfill the clinical competency requirements for endorsement.

Petition for: Endorsement of applicant's medical license from Germany.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Commissioner's Regulations allow endorsement of an applicant's license from another jurisdiction if appropriate requirements are met, and the applicant has not failed any part of New York State's licensing examination. A license granted in a foreign country can be endorsed if licensure in that country is regulated by an organization designated as responsible for quality assurance and acceptable to the Board of Regents. Additionally, the applicant must satisfactorily demonstrate completion of an acceptable proficiency examination, clinical competency examination, three years of American Council on Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited postgraduate training or the equivalent, and five years of satisfactory professional experience.

Dr. Elbau lacks three years of accredited postgraduate training. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine has reviewed the documentation submitted in support of Dr. Elbau's application. He recommends that Dr. Elbau's training be accepted as the equivalent of the three years of ACGME-accredited postgraduate training required for licensure.

Commissioner's Regulations allow the Board of Regents to accept appropriate foreign medical licenses and diplomate certificates to fulfill the license, proficiency, and clinical competency requirements for New York State licensure by endorsement. Dr. Elbau obtained his medical license in Germany in 2012. His German license is active and in good standing. Additionally, Dr. Elbau passed the USMLE step 1 and passed an examination for his Doctor in Neuroeconomics degree in September 2020 and passed the Facharztprufung examination leading to a Specialist Certification in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy in February 2021.

The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine recommends that Dr. Elbau's German license be endorsed, and the USMLE step 1 exam along with his Doctor of Neuroeconomics degree, and Specialist certification in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy be accepted to fulfill the proficiency and clinical competency requirements for endorsement.

The applicable requirements of Section 3.57 of the Rules of the Board of Regents require completion of a medical education program in a foreign medical school satisfactory to the Department which does not grant the degree Doctor of Medicine (M.D.), and in which the philosophy and curriculum were equivalent, as determined by the Department in accordance with the policy of the Board of Regents, to those in programs leading to the degree Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) at medical schools in the United States satisfactory to, or registered by, the Board of Regents and the Department. Secondly, petitioners must have licensure to practice medicine in New York State in accordance with provisions of Section 6524 or 6528 of the Education Law or their equivalent as determined by the Board of Regents pursuant to their authority under Section 6506 of the Education Law.
