Four pathways to an HSE Diploma

High School Equivalency Exam

- The Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC™) has served as NYS' HSE Exam since 2014.
- Previously, the General Educational Development (GED®) test was in use since the 1940's.
- ► The TASC has five subtests: Reading; Writing; Social Studies: Math and Science.
- ► The Data Recognition Corporation (DRC) is the contracted provider of the TASC™.
- There are 244 approved Test Centers in NYS which administer the TASC™.

24 College Credit Pathway

- In accordance with CR 100.7 the college credit pathway to earning an HSE diploma has been a statewide option since the 1960's.
- College credits must be distributed among the following subject areas: English; Mathematics; Social Science; Natural Science; and Humanities.
- Credits must be earned from a degree granting institution within the United States.

National External Diploma Program (NEDP)


- NEDP is a small, but important pathway to earning an HSE diploma.
- NEDP enables participants to demonstrate proficiency through a comprehensive competency-based learning approach.
- While previously a local school district option, NEDP was adopted as a statewide pathway by the Board of Regents in 2016.

The Regents - HSE Exam Pathway

- The pathway to earning an HSE diploma by merging Regents credits with HSE Exam subtest scores was adopted by the Board of Regents in August 2018.
- Prior passing Regents exam scores can now be combined with passing TASC™ subtests from 2014 to present and/or GED® subtests from 2002-2013.
- While full battery of the TASC™ includes the following subtests Reading; Writing; Math; Science; and Social Studies - the Regents English Language Arts Exam may be used in place of (both) the Reading and Writing subtests.
- New processes are being developed to accommodate the large volume of applicants seeking this pathway.


NYS HSE Diplomas Awarded All Pathways
