About the Yavner Awards

The Board of Regents established the Louis E. Yavner Awards, funded by the late Regent Emeritus, Louis E. Yavner of NYC who served on the Board from 1975-1981.

The Yavner Awards, which consist of a Teaching Award and a Citizen Award, applauds those who have made a substantial contribution to education about the Holocaust and other violations of human rights.

The first awardee was made in 1982 and the citizen award was first initiated in 1986.
