






Annual Program Review Trends

 OCUE receives between 1,250 and 1,700 proposals each year.








Program Review by Sector


Percentage of OCUE Proposals by Sector

 In 2023, we see an increase in the percentage of educator preparation proposals.




Regulatory changes affecting educator preparation programs

- Residency programs/certificate




Program Review Timelines







SARA Online Enrollment Activity


Exclusively Distance Education Enrollments at NYS SARA Institutions
