

State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA)

SARA is an agreement among member states that establishes comparable standards for interstate distance education.

- Under SARA, the Department reviews NYS Institutions of Higher Education (IHEs) for approval to offer distance education programs in other SARA member states.
- The Department also reviews out-of-state institutions that are not participating in SARA for approval to offer distance education to students located in New York State.
