## **Definition: Clinical Clerkships**

#### **Supervised educational experience**









Part of the clinical component of an undergraduate medical education

Takes place in a general hospital or equivalent health organization

Meets all requirements of the jurisdiction in which the facility is located

3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years of a fouryear medical school program



## **Definition (Continued): Clinical Clerkships**

 All clerkship students from international medical schools must be approved by the Department.

• Long-term clinical clerkship: total clerkship experience exceeds 12 weeks. Students must come from schools approved by the Department.

• Short-term clerkships may come from other international medical

schools.



## Regulation

# Defined in the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education

- §60.2 Clinical clerkships
- §60.10 Standards and process for the approval of international medical schools to place students in long-term clinical clerkships in New York State.





### **Advisory Committee Membership**

#### ...as appointed by the Chancellor

- ✓ 2 members of the Board of Regents (co-chairs)
- ✓ Chairperson of the State Board for Medicine (co-chair)
- ✓ Executive Secretary of the State Board for Medicine (non-voting)
- ✓ 1 representative of the Department of Health
- ✓ 2 physicians—experienced in the evaluation of medical education programs
- ✓ 2 representatives of approved international medical schools
- ✓ 2 representatives of medical schools registered in New York State
- ✓ 2 representatives from hospitals that serve as clinical clerkship sites in NYS
- ✓ other members as appointed by the Chancellor, upon consultation with the Board of Regents





## **Advisory Committee Duties**

Recommend standards for assessing applications by international medical schools

Recommend the process for assessing such applications

Appoint site review teams

Issue a report and recommendation on each application and review

- Application to the Department

- Confirmation of clerkship appointment (short term clerkships)
- Proof of infection control training
- Proof of passing score on the United States Medical Licensing Examination Step 1 (for students from approved schools)
