


#### New York State Arts Education Data

In the 2019-20 School year

- Students without access to the arts dropped to 4.3%
- 2,096,627 students were enrolled in arts courses

### Individual Arts Assessment Pathway (IAAP)






Locally determined three-unit sequence in the arts

Preparation for future experiences and opportunities in the arts!




### Expansive, Inclusive, Equitable Arts Education for all Students

# Individual Arts Assessment Pathway Three-year Pilot 2022-2025

- 25 School districts and 48 schools
- 2022-2023 enrollment is a diverse group of 1,140 9<sup>th</sup> graders



### IAAP Development Timeline

Virtual asynchronous work to prepare drafts of materials for review

July-Aug. 2021

Selection of schools for pilot; final pilot preparations

Nov.-Dec. 2021

Planning time; monitor and assist pilot schools with local IAAP development

Jan.-Aug. 2022

Revise IAAP materials based on pilot feedback; IAAP applications open for all districts

Spring 2023

Sep.-Oct. 2021

Survey districts interested in pilot participation

Jan. 2022

Dissemination of pilot materials for planning to selected pilot schools


Sep. 2022
