









Teach New York

- State-customized teacher recruitment system developed by Teach.org in collaboration with NYSED
- From March 2024 to mid-February 2025:
 - o 64,103 sign-ups
 - 70% identified as people of color
 - 1,386 event and group coaching registrations
 - 462 1:1 coaching call registrations
 - 46 NYS educator preparation program letters of participation
