


### How Does NY Compare to Other States?



### Total Credits Required for the Minimum High School Diploma







#### **Minimum Number of ELA Credits for High School Diploma**

### Minimum Number of Math Credits for High School Diploma








#### **Minimum Number of Science Credits for High School Diploma**

## **Potential Goals**

- Prepare students for 21<sup>st</sup> century post secondary options

- Expand external certification assessment options
- Allow students to demonstrate proficiency in multiple ways
