#### Implications of the Graduation Measures Recommendations

- At the June 2024 Board of Regents meeting, the Department described four transformations in its vision for graduation measures.
- Today, we will discuss the implications of these transformations on educator preparation programs.





#### Transformation #1: Adopt the NYS Portrait of a Graduate

- The NYS Portrait of a Graduate becomes the framework for future diploma requirements.
- All students must demonstrate proficiency in each component to earn a high school diploma.





#### **Transformation #2: Redefine Credits**

Organize diploma requirements by the components of the Portrait of a Graduate

Add new requirements for CTE and financial literacy


Expand ways for students to show evidence of proficiency in the learning standards and the components of the Portrait of a Graduate



### Transformation #3: Sunset Diploma Requirements

Students will no longer need to "pass the Regents" or a +1 Pathway Assessment to graduate.

State assessments will continue to be administered per federal ESSA requirements.





### Transformation #4: Move to One Diploma



Advanced designation would become a seal or endorsement.



Districts must confer diplomas to students who satisfy the State's requirements.



Districts can add additional seals or endorsements.
