2022-23 State Aid

The 2022-23 enacted budget:

Funds second year of full phase-in of Foundation Aid formula



Provides \$2.1 billion total year-to-year increase and 3% minimum increase for all districts

Fully funds all expense-based aids; does not change current law



School Mental Health and Pre-K Grants



Mental Health Grants

- \$100M over 2 years
- Matches local, State, and/or Federal funds
- RFP under development

Pre-Kindergarten Expansion

- \$100M allocated to 336 school districts, including 29 districts without existing state-funded pre-K program
- \$25M for RFP

Spending Plan Requirements



Foundation Aid

- Districts with increase of 10% or \$10M
- Goals, investments, fund balance, analysis of public comment




American Rescue Plan

- Goals, investments, fund balance, analysis of public comment


