

Adult Education Data


National Data

- Literacy - 59 million adults have literacy skills at or below Level 1 (lowest level)
- Numeracy - 72 million adults have numeracy skills at or below the lowest level
- 1 in 5 employees in the workforce are newcomers to the U.S.
- 46% of people new to the U.S. are not proficient in English
- 25% of newcomers do not have a high school diploma

New York State Data


- 1.6 million New Yorkers lack a high school diploma or equivalency
- 1.8 million New Yorkers have limited English proficiency
- Many working New Yorkers face barriers to career advancement

Literacy and Employment




Decreasing Poverty
