- Correct conflicting supplement and not supplant language



# Special Education

- State support for Free and Appropriate Public Education until 22:
  - Hold harmless for school age special education programs
  - Require state agencies to convene to make recommendations on how to expand residential opportunities
  - Tuition rate growth factor



## School Aid

- Short-term Foundation Aid changes
- Continued need for funding for deeper Foundation Aid study
- Growth aid for districts with significant enrollment increases
- Increase the BOCES Aid Salary Cap
- Enhance Special Services Aid

# Expand Access to College and CTE Course Work

#### **Early College**

• Create a new "College Course Aid" funding formula to increase partnerships between school districts and institutions of higher education (IHEs) to provide greater access to college-level coursework in high school, and to support the costs for college credit

#### CTE

- Expand funding to increase access to CTE courses for all high school students
- Increase reimbursements for CTE teachers
