

2021-2022 Budget – Foundation Aid






First current law increase since 2008-2009



2022-2023 Current Law – Foundation Aid





Fully Fund Expense-Based Aids

Aid for reimbursement-based services such as transportation, building, BOCES

Annual increases range from \$100 million to \$400 million

> Actual data available November 15, 2021

Regents have opposed prior Executive proposals to consolidate/reduce expensebased aids

Increase Access and Opportunity through BOCES Aid Expansion


Raising aidable salary range to support:

- Career and Technical Education






Increase Access to Instructional Materials by Revising Outdated Funding Levels






