Definitions:

Branch Campus: "a unit of an institution located at a place other than the institution's principal center . . . at which the institution offers one or more curricula leading to a certificate or degree [§50.1(r) of the Commissioner's Regulations]." An institution's branch campuses within New York State are authorized by the Board of Regents. Once a location is authorized as a branch campus it always should be reported as such, even if the institution no longer offers one or more complete programs at the location, so long as any instruction is offered there. Branch campuses located outside New York State are not subject to authorization by the Board of Regents; however, they should be reported.

Extension Center: "a unit of an institution located at a place other than the institution's principal center . . . at which the institution does not offer any curricula leading to a certificate or degree, but at which the institution either conducts more than 15 [different] courses for credit or has more than 350 course registrations for credit in any academic year [July 1 – June 30] [§50.1(s) of the Commissioner's Regulations]." A location meeting this definition that is not in an exempt location (listed below) must be approved by the Commissioner of Education. Once approved, it always should be reported as an extension center (unless the approval has been terminated) even in an academic year when it no longer meets the size criteria. Exempt locations should be reported as extension centers only for an academic year when the size criteria are met.

Extension Site: "a unit of an institution located at a place other than the institution's principal center . . . at which the institution does not offer any curricula leading to a certificate or degree, and at which the institution conducts no more than 15 [different] courses for credit and has no more than 350 course registrations for credit in an academic year [July 1 – June 30] [§50.1(t) of the Commissioner's Regulations]."

Exempt Locations: (providing coursework or curricula registered at the institution's principal center or branch campus)

- Locations outside the state or on territory over which the Federal government has asserted exclusive jurisdiction.
- Locations with facilities unavailable at the principal center and required by registered clinical or field curricula.
- Locations within a secondary school providing courses to secondary students for degree credit.
- Locations providing courses or curricula within a correctional facility.
- Locations providing courses or curricula on the territory of a Native American reservation.

Counts of Extension Centers and Sites include only locations that were active, registering one or more students for the year shown.
