Background Information

Bethel Seminary of the East is a provisionally chartered institution and until such time as its charter is made absolute, section 224 of the Education Law requires that the Regents award degrees on its behalf.

Information in Support of Recommendation

Bethel Seminary of the East

Bethel Seminary of the East was granted a provisional charter by the Board of Regents on May 23, 2006, authorizing the Seminary to confer the Master of Divinity (M.Div.) and Master of Arts (M.A.) degrees. Until the Regents grant Bethel Seminary of the East an absolute charter, all academic awards are to be conferred on graduates by the Regents.
