Issue for Consent Agenda

Required by State Statute.

Proposed Handling

Procedural History

Section 6506(5) of the Education Law and Section 24.7 of the Rules of the Board of Regents authorize the Regents to waive education, experience and examination requirements for a professional license as well as to confer the degree Doctor of Medicine.

Background Information

There are two licensing petitions and 41 requests for the conferral of the degree Doctor of Medicine for review and approval.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Regents approve the recommendations of the Committee on the Professions regarding licensing petitions.

Approval of the Committee on the Professions' recommendations will be effective September 17, 2015.

DENTISTRY

15-09-50 Spyridon Varthis New York, NY

(Universitatea de Medicina si Farmacie "Iuliu Hatieganu," Cluj-Napoca, Romania, Doctor-Medic in Stomatology, September 2004)

<u>Petition for</u>: Acceptance of education.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: An applicant for licensure in dentistry who has completed a program of dental education in an unregistered or unaccredited dental school is required to complete two academic years of study in an accredited dental school program culminating in certification that the applicant has achieved the level of knowledge and clinical proficiency expected of a graduate of that school.

Dr. Varthis completed three academic years of study from July 2010 to June 2013, culminating in a Master of Science degree + specialty certificate in Prosthodontics at Columbia University in New York, New York. Columbia University has certified that Dr. Varthis achieved the level of knowledge and clinical proficiency expected of a graduate of the general dentistry program. The Executive Secretary of the State Board for Dentistry recommends that his advanced education be considered as the substantial equivalent of the two-year program required in Regulation.

(4) Satisfactory scores on Parts I and II of the National Dental Board Examinations.	(4)

(5) Acceptable clinically-based dental residency program of at least one year's duration.	(5)
(6) United States citizen or alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the United States.	(6)
(7) Evidence of the required course in the identification and reporting of child abuse and maltreatment.	(7) Certification of Attendance for Training in Identifying and Reporting of Child Abuse and Maltreatment.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: The Committee on the Professions, in concurrence with the Executive Secretary of the State Board for Dentistry, recommends that the applicant's professional education requirements be considered fulfilled.

VETERINARY MEDICINE

15-02-75 Constance E. De Haan Novato, CA

(U.C. Davis, School of Veterinary Medicine, Davis, CA. DVM 1986)

<u>Petition for</u>: Waiver of New York State requirements pertaining to acceptability of licensing examinations for licensure by endorsement.

<u>Statement of Problem</u>: Dr. De Haan graduated from an accredited college of veterinary medicine in 1986 and took the National Board (NBE) examination in December 1985. Dr. De Haan has not taken the Clinical Competency Test (CCT). For New York State licensure, applicants who passed the NBE have typically been required to pass the Clinical Competency Test (CCT). Both the NBE and the CCT have been replaced by the North American Veterinary Licensing Examination (NAVLE).

Dr. De Haan is currently licensed in California and Oregon and has documented over twenty years of practice in California. Dr. De Haan was licensed in California based on passing the NBE.

In view of Dr. De Haan's documentation of numerous years of practice as evidence of clinical competence, the Executive Secretary of the State Board for Veterinary Medicine recommends that the CCT examination requirement be waived and that the applicant's license be accepted for endorsement in New York State.

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<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: The Committee on the Professions, in concurrence with the Executive Secretary of the State Board for Veterinary Medicine, recommends waiver of the CCT examination requirement and endorsement of the applicant's license.

NOW ELIGIBLE FOR LICENSURE

MEDICINE

<u>Petition for</u>: Conferral of the degree Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) pursuant to Section 6529 of the Education Law.

<u>Summary Statement</u>: The petitioners listed below are all graduates of foreign medical schools who have been licensed in New York.

The applicable requirements of Section 3.57 of the Rules of the Board of Regents require completion of a medical education program in a foreign medical school satisfactory to the Department which does not grant the degree Doctor of Medicine (M.D.), and in which the philosophy and curriculum were equivalent, as determined by the Department in accordance with the policy of the Board of Regents, to those in programs leading to the degree Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) at medical schools in the United States satisfactory to, or registered by, the Board of Regents and the Department. Secondly, petitioners must have licensure to practice medicine in New York State in accordance with provisions of Section 6524 or 6528 of the Education Law or their equivalent as determined by the Board of Regents pursuant to their authority under Section 6506 of the Education Law.
