SUMMARY

Issue for Decision

Should the Regents approve the proposed charter revisions for Democracy Prep Charter School and Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem, which are authorized by the Chancellor of the New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE)?

Reason(s) for Consideration

Required by New York State law.

Proposed Handling

This issue will be before the Board of Regents P-12 Education Committee and the Full Board for action at the September 2015 Regents meeting.

Background Information

Both Democracy Prep Charter School and Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem have submitted charter revision requests to the Chancellor of the NYCDOE to take the following actions:

- The schools seek to change their special education programs by creating a Pathways program, and will add a facility to the charter.
- The Pathways program is an intensive, one-year transition program that will offer programming and services to students with disabilities with the greatest academic needs through a cooperative arrangement between the schools and

Democracy Prep Public Schools Inc. Pathways will potentially grow by 1-2 students per year for each school.

- Pathways will be located at a private facility in Harlem leased and provided by Democracy Prep Public Schools at no cost to the schools. The facility will be an additional location for Democracy Prep Charter School and Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem.
- The Pathways program has the potential to revolutionize how the school serves its students with disabilities and will provide a benefit for these students with the greatest needs and give these students the same opportunity to succeed as their peers who are in out-of-district private programs.

Democracy Prep Charter School

Democracy Prep Charter School (or "DPCS") was first authorized by the Chancellor of the NYCDOE as a charter school to open for the 2006-2007 school year. DPCS is in the third charter term and was issued a five-year full term renewal in May 2015. DPCS is serving 1,061 students in Grades 6-12 for the 2014-2015 school year. DPCS is authorized to serve students in grades K-12.

The chart below outlines the material terms of Democracy Prep Charter School's charter and the proposed revision.

- DPCS received a full term renewal in May 2015. At the time of renewal, the school demonstrated academic success.
- Annual aggregate English Language Arts (ELA) and math proficiency rates on NYS assessments for DPCS students have consistently exceeded those of Community School District (CSD) 5 during the current charter term.
- In 2013-2014, 25.1% of DPCS students were proficient in ELA on the NYS assessments; this placed the School at the 71st percentile citywide and 100th percentile amongst peer schools.
- Also in 2013-2014, 48.9% of DPCS students were proficient in math on the NYS assessments; this placed the School at the 82nd percentile citywide and 95th percentile amongst peer schools.
- DPCS is split-sited in DOE-operated space. Grades 6-8 are sited in DOE-operated space located at 2230 5th Avenue, New York, NY 10037; the school is co-located with P.S. 197 John B. Russwurm. Grades 9-12 are sited in DOE-operated space located at 222 West 134th Street, New York, NY 10030; the school is co-located with P.S. 092 Mary McLeod Bethune.

Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem

Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem (or "DPH") was first authorized by the Chancellor of the NYCDOE as a charter school to open for the 2010-2011 school year. DPH is in the second term and was issued a 4.5 year renewal in January 2015. DPH is currently serving 1,309 students in Grades K-12 for the 2014-2015 school year. DPH is authorized to serve students in grades K-12.

The chart below outlines the material terms of Democracy Prep Charter School-Harlem and the proposed revision.

- DPH received a 4.5 year renewal in January 2015. At the time of renewal, DPH demonstrated academic success.
- In 2013-2014, 15% of DPH students were proficient in ELA on the NYS assessments; this placed DPH at the 27th percentile citywide and 17th percentile amongst peer schools.
- Also in 2013-2014, 34.9% of DPH students were proficient in math on the NYS assessments; this placed DPH at the 50th percentile citywide and 47th percentile amongst peer schools.

• DPH is split-sited in private and DOE-operated space. Grades K-1 are sited in DOE-operated space located at 2005 Madison Avenue, New York, NY 10035; the school is co-located with The Urban Assembly School for Global Commerce, Harlem Children's Zone Promise Academy II Charter School and Choir Academy of Harlem. Grades 6-8 are sited in private space located at 207 West 133rd Street, New York, NY 10030. Grades 9-10 are sited in DOE-operated space located at 212 West 120th Street, New York, NY 10027; the school is located with an adult learning program.

Recommendation

VOTED: That the Board of Regents finds that the proposed revised charter: (1) meets the requirements set out in Article 56 of the Education Law, and all other applicable laws, rules and regulations; (2) will permit the charter school to operate in an educationally and fiscally sound manner; (3) is likely to improve student learning and achievement and materially further the purposes set out in subdivision two of section twenty-eight hundred fifty of Article 56 of the Education Law; and (4) will have a significant educational benefit to the students expected to attend the charter school, and the Board of Regents therefore approves the above listed charter revision as proposed by Chancellor of the NYCDOE and the provisional charter for the Democracy Prep Charter School is amended accordingly.

VOTED: That the Board of Regents finds that the proposed revised charter: (1) meets the requirements set out in Article 56 of the Education Law, and all other applicable laws, rules and regulations; (2) will permit the charter school to operate in an educationally and fiscally sound manner; (3) is likely to improve student learning and achievement and materially further the purposes set out in subdivision two of section twenty-eight hundred fifty of Article 56 of the Education Law; and (4) will have a significant educational benefit to the students expected to attend the charter school, and the Board of Regents therefore approves the above listed charter revision as proposed by Chancellor of the NYCDOE and the provisional charter for the Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem is amended accordingly.

Timetable for Implementation

The Regents action for Democracy Prep Charter School and Democracy Prep Charter School – Harlem would take effect immediately.
